Naomi Long MLA

Justice Minister, Northern Ireland Executive

Naomi Long MLA is the Justice Minister in the Northern Ireland Executive and represents the East Belfast constituency.



Ms. Long served as Lord Mayor of Belfast between 2009 and 2010. In 2010 she became the first Alliance MP elected to Westminster, as Member of Parliament for East Belfast. In May 2016, Ms. Long returned to the Northern Ireland Assembly as MLA for East Belfast.

The 2019 European election saw Ms Long elected as a MEP. Following the UK's exit from the European Union and negotiations to restore devolution, Ms. Long returned to the Northern Ireland Assembly in January 2020, serving as Justice Minister until October 2022. The reestablishment of the NI Assembly and Executive in February 2024 saw Ms. Long again appointed as Justice Minister.

Helen McEntee TD

Minister for Justice, Government of Ireland

Helen McEntee TD is the Minister for Justice of Ireland, a position held since June 2020.

She has represented the

Meath East constituency as a Teachta Dála (TD) since 2013. She previously served as Minister of State for European Affairs from 2017 to 2020 and Minister of State for Mental Health and Older People from 2016 to 2017.

Deputy McEntee was appointed by An Taoiseach Enda Kenny to the Oireachtas Committee on Transport and Communications.

She is also a member of the Oireachtas Committee on Environment, Culture and the Gaeltacht.

Lady Chief Justice & Chief Justice



The Rt. Hon. Dame Siobhan Keegan

Lady Chief Justice of Northern Ireland

Dame Siobhan Keegan graduated from Queen's University Belfast in 1993.

She has been a High Court Judge, served as Vice Chair of the Bar of Northern Ireland, Chair of the Young Bar, Chair of the Family Bar Association, Chair of the Bar Charity Committee and a member of the Bar Professional Conduct Committee.

Dame Siobhan was the Judge in Residence at the Queen's University Belfast and became a Bencher of the Northern Ireland Inn of Court, an Honorary Bencher of Gray's Inn and an Honorary

Bencher of King's Inns in 2022. She was a member of the Judicial Studies Board (JSB) and was also the Northern Ireland representative on the Franco-British-Irish Judicial Cooperation Committee.

Dame Siobhan has been the Presiding Coroner, the Senior Family Judge in the High Court of Northern Ireland, the designated Northern Ireland judicial member of the International Hague Network of Judges, was a Commissioner in the Northern Ireland Judicial Appointments Commission (NIJAC) and is now Chair of NIJAC.

Dame Siobhan was made an honorary member of the Society of Legal Scholars. She was sworn in as Lady Chief Justice of Northern Ireland on 2 September 2021.

In 2023, Queen's University Belfast conferred upon her an honorary degree in 'Doctor of Laws for Distinction in Public Service'.



The Hon. Mr. Justice Donal O'Donnell

Chief Justice Ireland

The Hon. Mr. Justice Donal O'Donnell was appointed the 13th Chief Justice of Ireland on the 11th October, 2021, by the President of Ireland, His Excellency Mr. Michael D. Higgins.

Mr. Justice Donal O'Donnell was born in Belfast and educated at St. Mary's C.B.S., University College Dublin (B.C.L.)., the Honorable Society of King's Inns (B.L.) and the University of Virgina (LL.M).

Mr. Justice O'Donnell was called to the Bar of Ireland in 1982, commenced practice in 1983 and was called to the Bar of Northern Ireland in 1989. In 1995, he was appointed a Senior Counsel and has practised in all of the Courts of Ireland, in the Court of Justice of the European Union and in the European Court of Human Rights.

Mr. Justice O'Donnell was appointed a judge of the Supreme Court in 2010. He was a member of the Law Reform Commission from 2005 to 2012. Lectures he has delivered include the John Kelly lecture (U.C.D), the Brian Walsh lecture (I.S.E.L.), the Brian Lenihan lecture (T.C.D.), the Dan Binchy lecture (Brehon Law School) and the keynote address at a conference at the University of Limerick to mark the 80th anniversary of the Constitution of Ireland.

He has published articles on a variety of legal topics in publications including the Northern Ireland Legal Quarterly, the Irish Jurist, the Dublin University Law Journal, the Judicial Studies Journal, and has contributed to volumes of essays on legal issues. He was director of Our Lady's Hospice from 2009 to 2014. He was a Council member of the Irish Legal History Society from 2018 to 2021 and is now a Joint Patron of the Society. He is an Honorary members of the Society of Legal Scholars.

As Chief Justice, Mr. Justice O'Donnell is a member of the Council of State, the Presidential Commission, Chair of the Board of the Courts Service and Chair of the Judicial Council.




