

NOTICE PURSUANT TO GDPR ARTICLES 13 AND 14

The Barristers' Professional Conduct Tribunal (the 'Tribunal') is the data controller of any personal data being supplied in this form. The Tribunal can be contacted by mail to PO Box 4460, 158/159 Church Street, Dublin 7.

Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Tribunal is subject and/or for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest by the Tribunal.

The recipients of your personal data may include the Tribunal (its members and staff), the other party/parties to the complaint, any witnesses, the Barristers' Professional Conduct Appeals Board, the Bar Council of Ireland, the Professional Practices Committee of the Bar of Ireland, the Disciplinary Committee of the Benchers of the Honorable Society of King's Inns, the Complaints Committee of the Legal Services Regulatory Authority, and the Legal Practitioners Disciplinary Tribunal.

Your personal data will be kept for no longer than is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed.

You have the right to request from the Tribunal access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning you and to object to processing as well as the right to data portability.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Commission if you think that the Tribunal's processing of your personal data infringes any aspect of data protection law.

The personal data processed by the Tribunal originates from the complaint form, the response, any further information received from either party, or any evidence given to the Tribunal at an oral hearing.

The Tribunal may obtain personal data relating to you from the other party to the complaint. You will be notified of this within a reasonable period after obtaining the personal data, but at the latest within one month.
